

"All School" Team League

I. November 2 – December 7, 2014

- A. Each team will play two (2) games each Sunday during 6-week period.
- B. 12 Game league
- C. Game times: 1:30pm, 2:30pm, 3:30pm, 4:30pm (12:30pm and 5:30pm may be used)

II . Eligible Teams

- 1. School Teams
 - 1. Teams consisting of players that all feed into the same High School
 - 2. Teams consisting of players that attend the same elementary or middle school
 - 3. All-Star teams may participate in the league, however, they must play up
- 2. Grades 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th
- 3. Boys and Girls Leagues
- D. Participating teams should be within 50 miles or approximately one-hour driving time from the furthest team in the league. Teams outside the recommended drive time may participate, but may lose the hosting ability.
- E. Teams should have the ability to host the league for one week during the league. The host teams must have access to two gymnasiums with access to gyms from approximately 12:00pm 6:00pm on Sunday afternoon.

III. Entry Fee

- A. \$375 per team
- B. To secure a spot in the league, teams must submit entry fee by Oct. 15, 2014.

IV. Host Team

- A. Each participating team should have the ability to host the league (1) Sunday during league play with access to two gymnasiums from approximately 1:00pm to 6:00pm.
- B. Teams participating in the league that are outside the recommended maximum driving distance for teams to travel may lose their ability to act as a "Host Team."
- C. Host Team Responsibilities
 - 1. Schedule qualified officials
 - 2. Compensate officials
 - 3. Supply Clock Keepers
 - 4. Schedule gate workers
 - 5. Schedule concession workers
- D. Host Team will receive all profits from gate receipts and concessions sold. Each host team will have the ability to more than cover their league entry fee plus make a profit for their team. Total profits will depend largely upon the ability of the hosting team to secure volunteers/parents that are willing to work for the team.

Note: If volunteer officials are used they must be approved by Midwest Youth Tournaments.

V. Admission

A. The following established admission prices must be used by Host Teams:

Adults - \$4 Students 6-18 - \$2 Children 5 & under – Free

VI. Registration and Roster Information

- A. Teams must submit registration with entry fee by Oct. 15, 2014.
- B. A completed roster must be submitted to Midwest Youth Tournaments by the start of the first game on week 1.
- C. In no instance may a player be added to the roster after the league begins.
- D. Although birth certificates and report cards are not required to be submitted teams should have such documentation available should a protest occur questioning a player's grade and age.

- E. Should a player be found to be ineligible for the league in which he or she is playing, the following will apply:
 - 1. Player may not continue playing in the league nor be allowed to participate on any team within any leagues operated by Midwest Youth Tournaments for the current league season.
 - 2. All games that the player has participated in will be forfeited. The team will be allowed to continue in league play without the player.

VII. School Team "Tournament of Champions"

All teams participating in the "All School Team" Travel League are eligible to participate in the Midwest Youth Tournaments School Team "Tournament of Champions" January 10-11, 2014 in Bloomington, IN at a reduced entry fee of \$200 (normal fee: \$225). The tournament is a 3 Game Guarantee – 2 Pool Games with all teams advancing to a seeded single elimination tournament.
